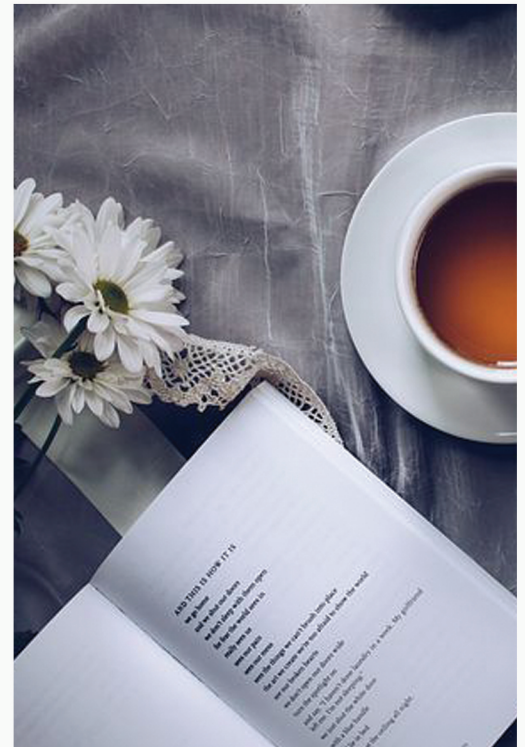

Sir Magdi Habib Yacoub

Sir Magdi Habib Yacoub (born 16 November 1935), is an Coptic Egyptian-British retired professor of cardiothoracic surgery at Imperial College London, best known for his early work in repairing heart valves with surgeon Donald Ross, adapting the Ross procedure, where the diseased aortic valve is replaced with the person's own pulmonary valve, devising the arterial switch operation (ASO) in transposition of the great arteries, and establishing the heart transplantation center at Harefield Hospital in 1980 with a heart transplant for Derrick Morris, who at the time of his death was Europe's longest-surviving heart transplant recipient. Yacoub subsequently performed the UK's first combined heart and lung transplant in 1983.

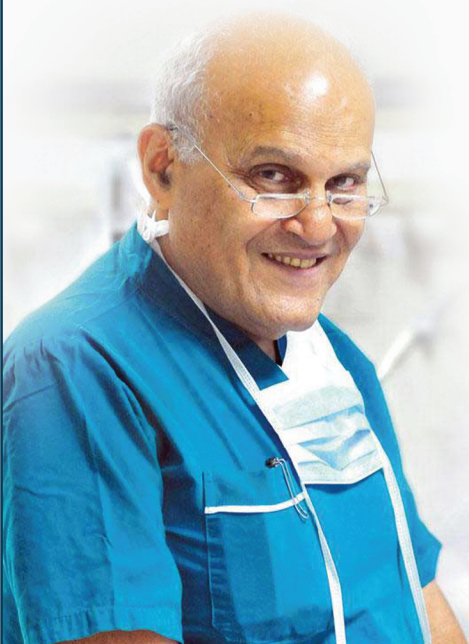
From 1986 to 2006, he held the position of British Heart Foundation Professor of Cardiothoracic Surgery at the National Heart and Lung Institute, Imperial College Faculty of Medicine. He is the founding editor of the journal *Disease Models & Mechanisms*.



His honors and awards include the Bradshaw Lecture from the Royal College of Physicians in 1988, a knighthood in the 1992 New Year Honors, the Texas Heart Institute's Ray C. Fish Award for Scientific Achievement in Cardiovascular Disease in 1998, the International Society for Heart and Lung Transplantation Lifetime

Achievement Award in 2004, the European Society of Cardiology's gold medal in 2006, the Order of Merit in 2014, the Lister Medal from the Royal College of Surgeons in 2015 and the Khalaf Ahmad Al Habtoor Achievement Award (KAHAA) in 2019.

Following retirement from the National Health Service (NHS), he continued to operate on children through his charity, Chain of Hope. In 2008, he co-founded the Magdi Yacoub heart foundation, which launched the Aswan Heart project.

MIRAL: WELL LISTEN, HAFSA, ON THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER 2019, THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION REPORTED THE EMERGENCE OF SOME CASES OF PNEUMONIA OF UNKNOWN CAUSE IN CHINA, SPECIFICALLY IN THE CITY OF WUHAN, AND THEN THE CHINESE AUTHORITIES SAID THAT THE CAUSE OF THOSE CASES WAS THE EMERGING CORONA VIRUS. .

HAFSA: YES, MIRAL, I HAVE READ THAT CORONA VIRUSES (COV) ARE A LARGE FAMILY OF VIRUSES THAT LEAD TO THE EMERGENCE OF DISEASES THAT ARE LIKE THE COMMON COLD TO VERY DANGEROUS DISEASES.

MIRAL: UNFORTUNATELY, THE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 ARE VARIABLE, AND MAY BE VERY SIMILAR TO THE COMMON COLD.

HAFSA: BUT WHAT ARE THE COMMON SYMPTOMS OF THE CORONA VIRUS?

MIRAL: PEOPLE INFECTED WITH THE CORONAVIRUS SUFFER FROM A VARIETY OF SYMPTOMS, WHICH MAY BE MILD OR SEVERE, BUT THE COMMON SYMPTOMS REPORTED BY INFECTED PEOPLE ARE (FEVER OR CHILLS, COUGH AND SHORTNESS OF BREATH, FATIGUE AND MUSCLE OR BODY ACHES, HEADACHE, LOSS OF SENSE). TASTE AND SMELL, SORE THROAT, CONGESTION OR RUNNY NOSE, NAUSEA OR VOMITING, DIARRHOEA).

HAFSA: AND WHEN DO THESE SYMPTOMS APPEAR?

MIRAL: THESE SYMPTOMS MAY APPEAR 2-14 DAYS AFTER INFECTION WITH THE VIRUS.

HAFSA: SO WE MUST PROTECT OURSELVES FROM THE CORONA VIRUS

MIRAL: OF COURSE, HAFSA, WHICH IS WHY THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION HAS ALWAYS URGED US TO TAKE SOME PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES.

HAFSA: OF COURSE, MIRAL, LIKE WE GET THE VIRUS VACCINE, AND WE WEAR THE MASK AS LONG AS WE ARE IN A CROWDED PLACE, OR IF WE ARE IN A PUBLIC PLACE.

MIRAL: AND IF WE GET INFECTED WITH THE CORONA VIRUS, WE MUST ISOLATE OURSELVES FROM EVERYONE ELSE, AND GET THE APPROPRIATE TREATMENTS.

HAFSA: IT IS NECESSARY THAT WE TAKE VITAMIN C AND SOME MEDICINES THAT HELP US TO STRENGTHEN IMMUNITY SO THAT WE CAN FIGHT THE VIRUS.

MIRAL: WE ALSO HAVE TO GO TO THE DOCTOR SO THAT HE CAN DIAGNOSE HOW SEVERE THE SYMPTOMS ARE AND WHAT WE NEED TO DO.

MIRAL: AND TO TRY AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE TO BE A METER AWAY FROM ANYONE, AND TO TRY TO AVOID BEING IN CROWDED PLACES, ESPECIALLY IF THEY ARE POORLY VENTILATED.

HAFSA: WE WASH OUR HANDS OFTEN WITH SOAP AND WATER FOR AT LEAST 20 SECONDS, ESPECIALLY AFTER WE ARE IN PUBLIC OR AFTER BLOWING OUR NOSE, COUGHING OR SNEEZING.

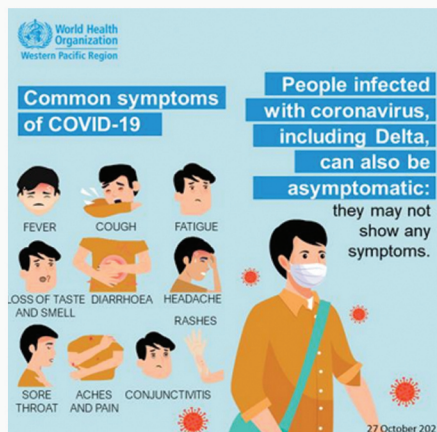
MIRAL: YES, AND IF WE DO NOT HAVE SOAP AND WATER, WE CAN USE HAND SANITIZERS THAT CONTAIN AT LEAST 60% ALCOHOL, AND COVER ALL SURFACES OF THE HAND AND RUB IT WELL UNTIL WE FEEL DRY.

HAFSA: WE MUST ALSO CLEAN THE SURFACES THAT WE TOUCH DAILY, SUCH AS TABLES, DOOR HANDLES, LIGHT SWITCHES, DESKS, TELEPHONES, TOILETS, AND OTHER THINGS THAT WE USE FREQUENTLY.

MIRAL: AND IF WE GET INFECTED WITH THE CORONA VIRUS, WE MUST ISOLATE OURSELVES FROM EVERYONE ELSE, AND GET THE APPROPRIATE TREATMENTS.

HAFSA: IT IS NECESSARY THAT WE TAKE VITAMIN C AND SOME MEDICINES THAT HELP US TO STRENGTHEN IMMUNITY SO THAT WE CAN FIGHT THE VIRUS.

Today we will talk about Alexandria library. The New Library Of Alexandria was opened on October 16, 2002

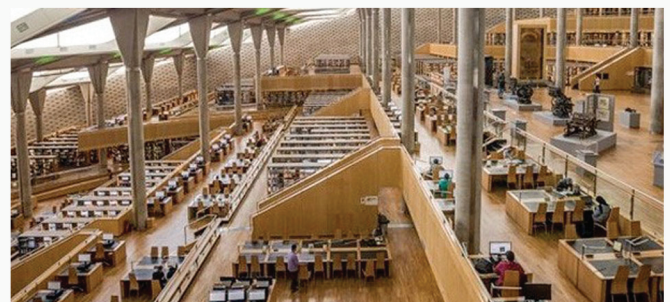
The library contains a large collection of books estimated at about 2 million and 153 thousand books in various languages of the world.

The membership of the Public Library of Books has reached more than 118 thousand members, and the library's services extend to students from 15 other governorates through "embassies of knowledge".

The library has 7 specialized libraries, which are the library for the blind, the audio-visual library, the children's library, the children's library, the rare books and special collections library, and the map library.

The library has 3 main museums, which are the Antiquities Museum, the Manuscripts Museum, and the Sadat Museum

The library is affiliated with the Planetarium Center, in a distinctive circular shape for the engineering building of the library and aims to spread scientific culture and hold exhibitions and workshops. It also contains a museum for the history of natural sciences

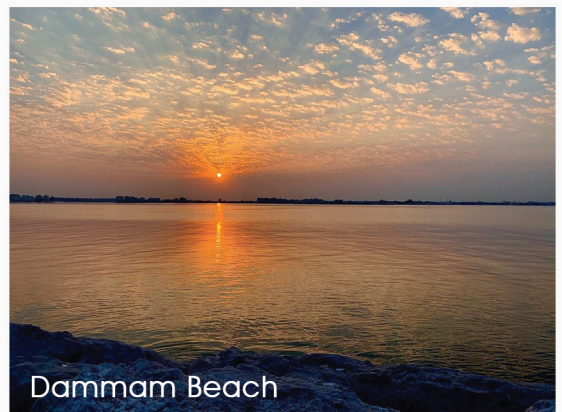

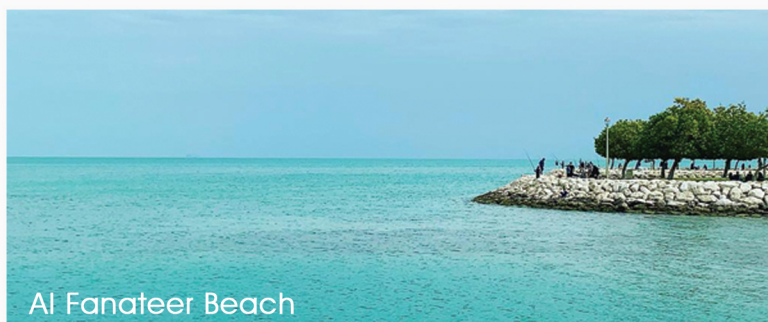
Dammam Beach

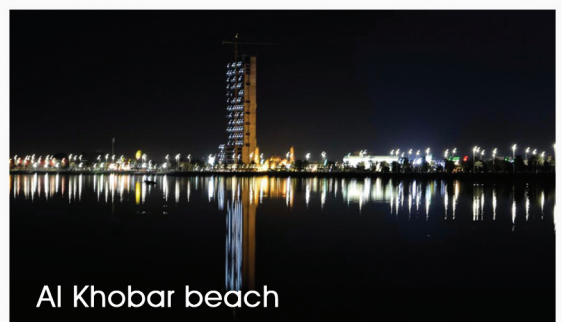

Weather in Egypt

Egypt has an arid (dry) climate. There is little rain, especially in the south. Alexandria, in the north, has the highest rainfall, with a mean of about 7 inches (17.5 centimeters) annually. Cairo gets only about 1 inch (2.5 centimeters) of rainfall annually.



In the spring and summer, early morning fogs on the Nile delta provide some additional moisture. Aswan, in southern Egypt, gets only about 0.1 inch (0.25 centimeter) of rain each year.

The Red Sea coastal plain and the Western Desert are also almost without precipitation. The Sinai Peninsula is a little less dry, with the northern part receiving about 5 inches (12.5 centimeters) of rain per year. Most of the rain in Egypt falls in the winter.

Egypt's winters are cool and mild, and its summers are hot. The mean annual temperature is 69 °F (20 °C). At midday in June, the mean high temperature is 91 °F (33 °C) at Cairo and 106 °F (41 °C) at Aswan.



Egypt has a very sunny climate. The country gets about 12 hours of sunshine per day in the summer and between 8 and 10 hours per day in the winter.

In the desert hot, dry winds called khamsins blow northward from the Sahara across Egypt to the Mediterranean coast. The khamsins, which often produce sandstorms, can last for several days, destroying crops.

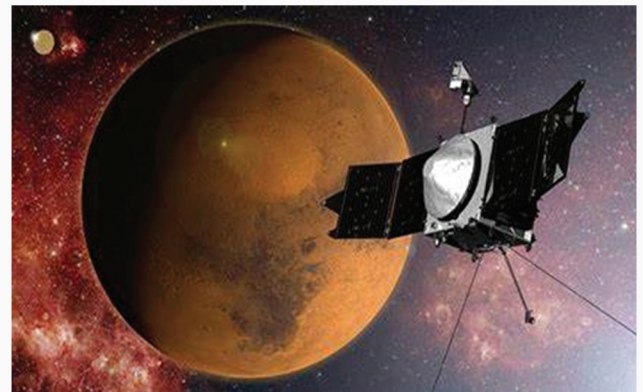

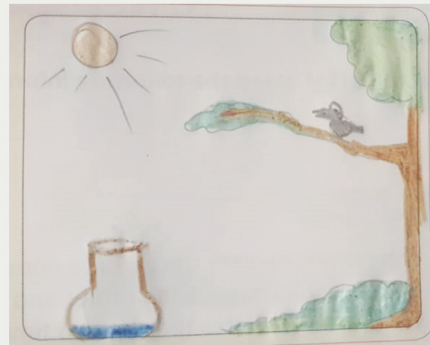

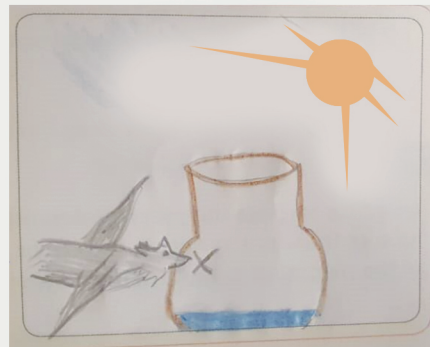

At last he saw a pitcher but the water was so low that the crow couldn't drink it .



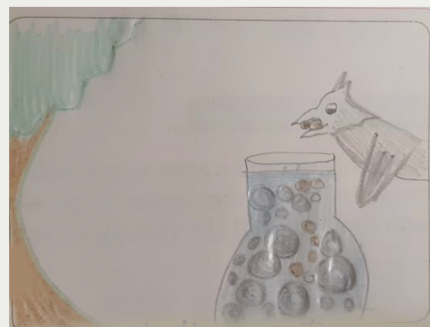

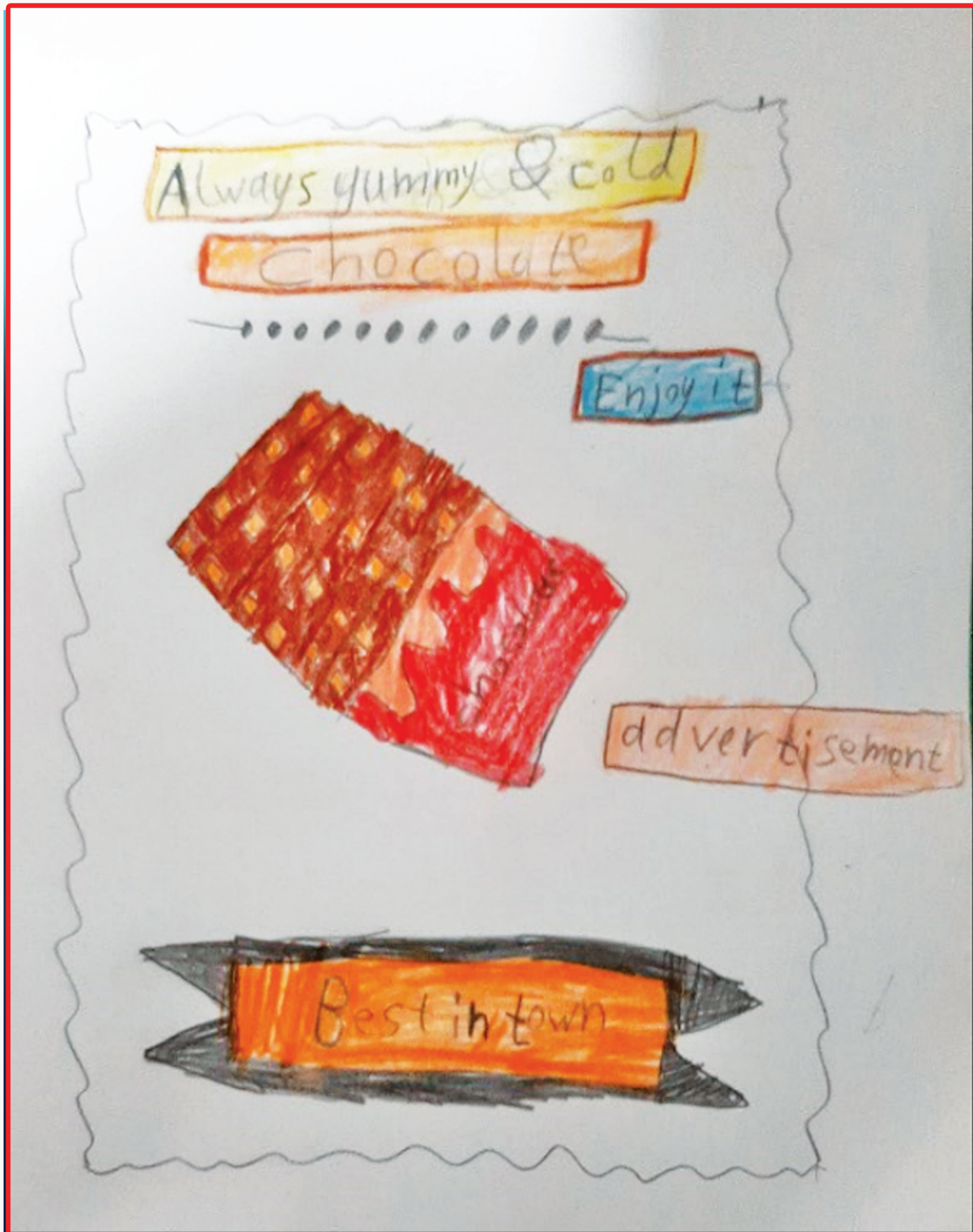
